2. Minutes of meeting on 19th January 2007.

Nic had agreed to enquire about the Autism Care Centre at the last meeting; he contacted Eden PR who had previously been in contact with us. The development changed hands in the summer of 2006 and Eden PR are no longer being used – the new company are not currently discussing the site.

Robin had spoken to a worker who was taking down poles near the boat club, he stated that they were burying cables.

The launch of TP Wood Recycling is on Saturday 24th February and it is hoped we will be able to make contacts with the press at the event. There were suggestions of possible partners/ contacts for the enterprise.
